- 5 Personal narrative which includes an explaination of how the scholarship will benefit the applicant

The deadline for applications is April 30. Scholarship Recipients will be notified. \$1000 is payable at \$500 per semester. Proof of enrollment must be provided in order to receive \$500 payment on the 1st semester. Recipient must maintain 12 credit hours & a 2.50 GPA. A transcript must be provided at the end of the 1st semester in order to receive \$500 payment on the 2nd semester. Failure to maintain a 2.5 GPA renders the Scholarship null and void.
